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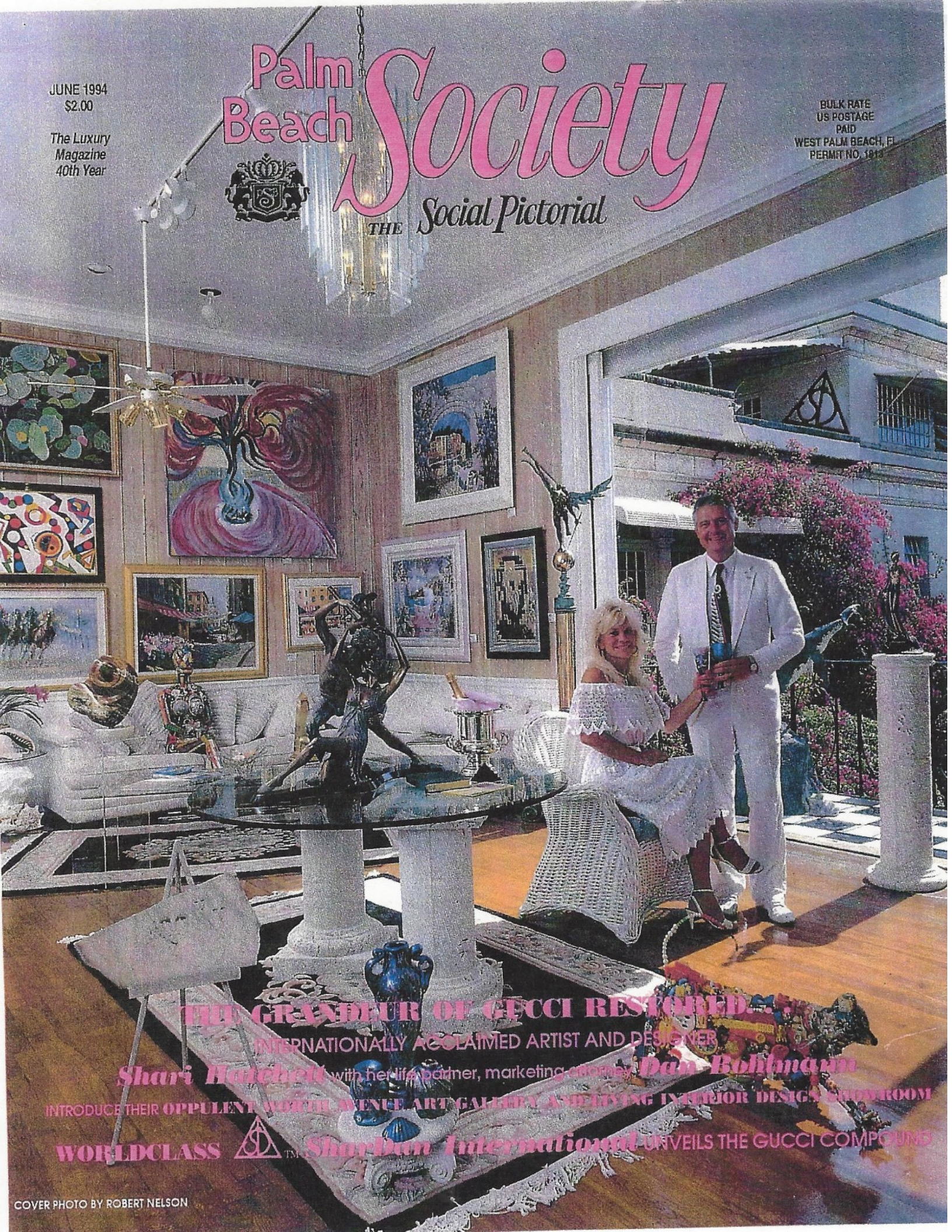

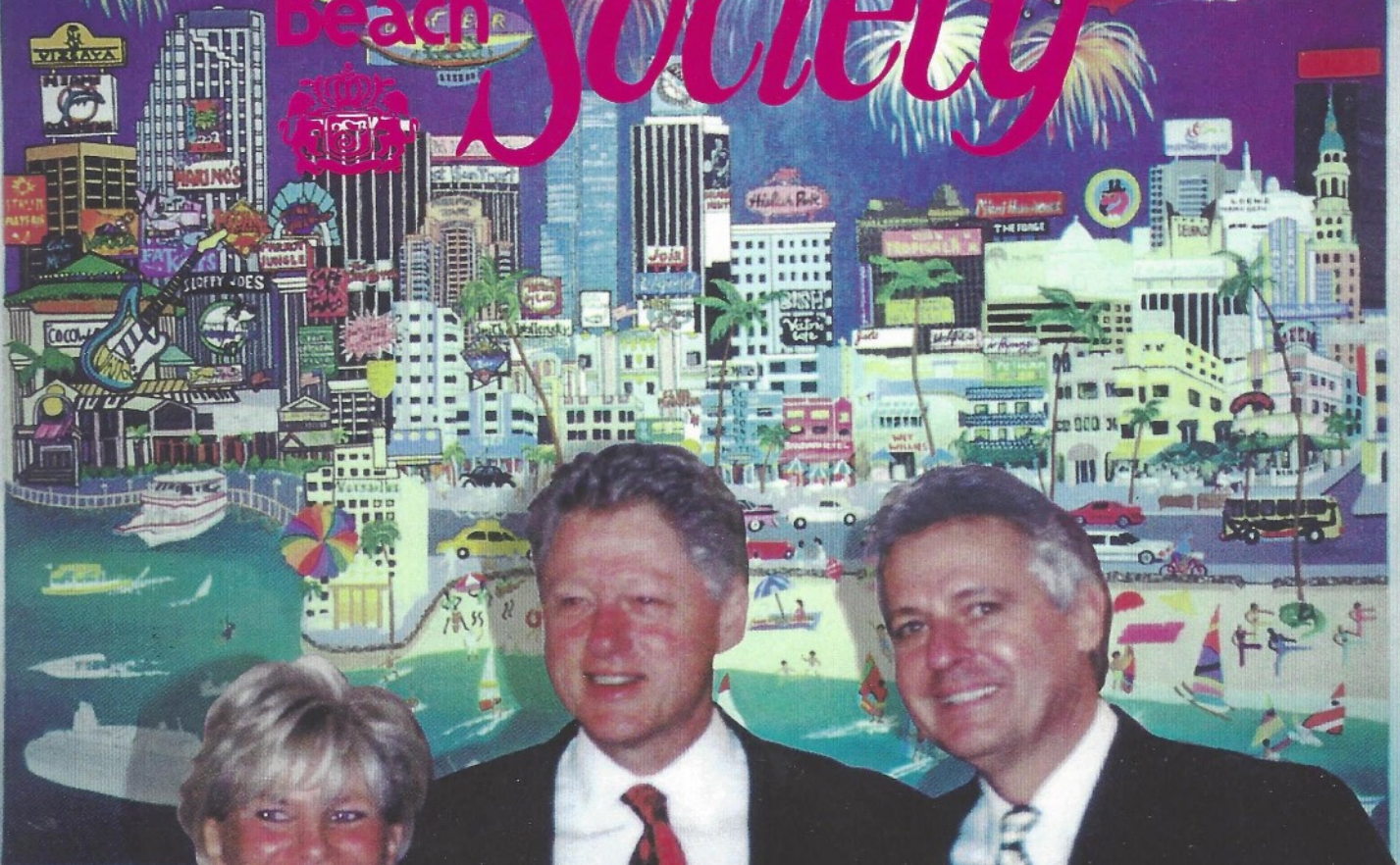

COVER ART: "Miami Millennium," In progress, by *Roxy™*

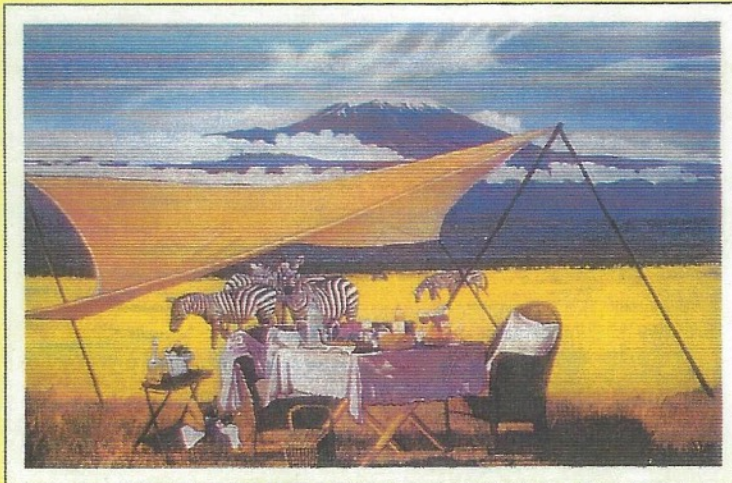
MAGICAL CITIES & ROOMS WITH VIEWS

Recently, SharDan has expanded their business to include Executive International Marketing Director, Sheila Friedman, who is busy licensing Sharie's images, most recently to be used on a line of designer products, including rugs, placemats, potholders, towels, Millennium products, stationery & note paper, boxes, jackets with LED lights and men's ties. Obviously, the never ending demand for her images, goes on and on.

SharDan, in addition to marketing Sharie's artwork for sale in fine art galleries, gift shops and on cruise lines "Auction at Sea Programs," make certain that the artwork is available as originals, limited editions, giclee on canvas, lithographs, serilithographs, posters and products for worldwide distribution. Monea Publishing and SharDan International are very excited to be introducing a mail-order catalogue later this year.

This exciting couple refuses to slow down. They are active in charity causes, donating tens of thousands of dollars in art each year to charities such as the Red Cross, Epilepsy Foundation, American Cancer Society, Aids benefit charities and dearest to Sharie's

heart, The Adam Walsh Children's Foundation. Sharie and Dan have started a workout wear, clothing and product design collaboration with Paul Monea for his future of fitness TaeBo exercise program. Paul is the brains behind the phenomenal rise of TaeBo exercise guru, Billy Blanks and other infomercial superstar programs. As this article is being written, The Paul Monea Charitable Foundation is being established to help worthy charitable causes around the world. The Paul Monea Family and their Integrity Global Marketing Corporation have personally selected Sharie to be their exclusive product line artistic director and graphic designer for promotions including The Stimulator, TaeBo, Stop Smoking and Lose Weight programs, together with their record-breaking Indy 500 Race Cars.

In 1987, Nancy and Ronald Reagan invited Sharie to be the selected artist to paint the White House and the annual Easter Egg Roll, a tradition for more than 100 years. This honor led to Sharie's painting the festivities represented at the 1987 Easter Egg Roll and presented to the Reagan's in 1988 at the ensuing event. That painting is now a permanent part of the White House Collection. Sharie has only recently learned that she is one of the finalists to paint the official Christmas card for the White House for 1999.

In addition, Sharie is almost as passionate about gourmet cooking and dining, as she is about art; therefore, she will be designing a Collectors Edition Cookbook to be released next year for the New Millennium. It will combine her fabulous illustrations with gourmet recipes from Sharie's personal collection. She assures us that the romance, beauty and whimsy in her art will be incorporated with designer dining around the world.

And, if that's not enough, Sharie is planning her "Rooms With A View" calendar for release in time for the new Millennium year 2000. No doubt when it makes its debut, Sharie's own personal calendar will be filled to overflowing with new, creative ideas to work on until the start of the year 2001.

To what does Sharie Hatchett Bohlmann attribute her success? Her answer "My art ability is a God given talent, and this gift, in combination with a 1000% support from my husband/life partner, Danny, knowing what you want and the perseverance to have it All!" Unserious golfer, serious painter

Shari Metzler was born longer ago than you'd think if you looked at her (which is not hard to do) in Houston, Texas, where Dad had a wholesale confection/comic book business. He'd been an All-American football player at Rice University. As Shari was growing up, she went to public schools, baby-sat her younger sisters, was a cheerleader, was good at all sports, and was an artist almost from the beginning.

How she got from Shari Metzler to Sharie Hatchett Bohlmann is an interesting story... far too long and convoluted to fit into this brief column, but I'll try to hit some highlights. If there were

any lowlights, she didn't mention them. But then again, she wouldn't. She's an explosion of positive energy and has been to a million places and done a million different things, one of the best of which was to marry Dan Bohlmann.

Frank Sinatra introduced them while Dan was doing some pro bono legal work for one of Frank's charity projects. Sharie (she added the "e" so that her married name wouldn't be 13 letters long... I think the operative word is "triskaidekaphobia") and Dan and Sharie didn't need Doctor Phil or e-Harmony when they met 16 years ago. She paints, he does his lawyering, and together they go on cruises, where she sets up a shipboard gallery and individualizes her paintings to buyers on the spot. They sell a ton of paintings on each cruise and, when in port, they go ashore and play golf. Doesn't sound like much of a hardship to me.

Sharie started selling her paintings at an early age when someone wanted to buy one and she said to herself "Why not?" She's been selling them ever since to the *Lifestyles of the Rich and Famous* group, as well as to people like you and me.

I've mentioned that Sharie's life has been full of interesting things such as going to Colombia, South America, to design a dog track. How many people can say that? She also lived in Key West, Fla., for six years, owned a ranch near Houston, qualified for the U.S. Olympics in fancy diving, lived in New York City where she modeled junior clothes (she was deemed too petite to be a runway model), was a Bunny at Gotham's Playboy Club where she met Sinatra and the whole rat pack, taught jazz dancing, and somewhere along the way became an "A" tennis player.

She didn't really get into golf until she moved to our desert in 1980, opened an art gallery on El Paseo and took up golf in a major way, hitting practice balls at the C.O.D. driving range and playing rounds with her girlfriends and customers at The Springs, Thunderbird, and other private clubs. She's been active in both the Sinatra Tournament and the Bob Hope Chrysler Classic, which parades right past her home at Bermuda Dunes Country Club. Her newest book of paintings won the Art Book of the Year award for 2008. Other than that, it's been a pretty non-eventful life for this over-achiever from Texas.

VALKENBURG • Ze is helemaal Amerikaans. Alle glamour en glitter die erbij hoort, is er, als Shari Hatchett binnenkomt in het kleine kamertje van een vakantiehuysje bovenop de Keuteberg in Schin op Geul. Een wat merkwaardige tegenstelling: de mestlucht uit de stallen van de boerderij en de Amerikaanse smil van Shari, geaccentueerd door de honderden glittersteentjes in de ketting om haar hals.

Dertig jaar geleden begon de Amerikaanse schilderijtjes te maken. Romantisch werk, noemt ze het zelf. Plaatjes van terrassetjes met uitzicht op de Caribische zee. Palmen, exotische bloemen, een glas champagne op tafel en de een of andere felgekleurde vogel op een tak, doen het erg goed in Amerika. Met de snelheid van een raket steeg ze in de Amerikaanse belangstelling. Helemaal toen ze ook nog primitieve collages van grote steden als New York en Las Vegas ging maken. De Amerikanen gingen uit hun dak.

Zo ook filmster-president Ronald Reagan. Hij vond het allemaal zo mooi dat hij haar uitkoos voor het maken van het jaarlijkse schilderij van het paasfeest op het Witte Huis. En omdat Reagan bevriend was met Frank Sinatra, moest die meteen ook een schilderij van haar hebben. Daarna ging haar naam rond in de kringen van de groten van het witte doek. Shari en haar man kwamen naar Limburg op uitnodiging van een vriend, die sinds kort haar manager is voor Europa, John Piek uit Schimmert. John en zijn vrouw Madelène leerden Shari kennen tijdens een cruise. De Schimmertenaar was meteen gecharmeerd van de kunstenaar en van haar werk. Hij zag daar wel brood in. Toen hij Shari's posters zelfs op de wc tegenkwam, wist hij wat hem te doen stond. Deze kunstenaar moest naar Limburg komen. Dé ideale promotie voor Valkenburg.

En dat lukte. Sinds anderhalve week logeert de Amerikaanse met haar man en een verzameling gedrukte kunstwerkjes in een kampeerboerderij in Schin op Geul, van God en iedereen verlaten.

De rust van de Keuteberg duurt niet lang, want gisteren maakte ze kennis met Valken-

burgs middenstand. Het zijn de Valkenburgse ondernemers immers, die straks van haar kunst kunnen profiteren.

In de komende dagen schieten Shari en Dan zo'n vijftien fotolijstjes vol met Valkenburg. Vooral de namen van de restaurantjes en hotels. Want die komen allemaal op het schilderij te staan. De eigenaar van die hotels en restaurants kan dan vervolgens via Schimmertse John afdrucken bestellen van het schilderij. Voor de omslag van zijn menu, als etiket voor wijn of bier, of gewoon als ingelijste poster aan de muur. Shari

is wat dat betreft nergens te beroerd voor. Een heel schilderij vol wolvenkrabbers, reclameborden, autootjes en mensjes, teruggebracht tot het formaat van de wijzerplaat van een horloge.

In april komt ze terug naar Valkenburg. Met het originele schilderij. Valkenburg Gold gaat het heten. „Het wordt een mengeling van romantiek en collage,” vertelt ze stralend. Vanaf dat moment kan de drukker aan de gang. Het origineel mag verkocht worden. Camille Oostwegel van Chateau Sint Gerlachus heeft al laten weten

dat hij er belangstelling voor heeft. Voor een slordige 25.000 dollar kan hij de eigenaar worden van het originele Valkenburg Gold. En daarmee bevindt hij zich dan meteen in het selecte gezelschap van Reagan, Sinatra en nog wat coryfeen. Voor wat de kunst betreft, dan. Om de pijn van de niet onaanzienlijke prijs een beetje te verzachten, vertelt Shari, dat ze altijd minstens tien procent ervan weggeeft aan een goed doel. Om haar hals hangt een gouden ketting met in talloze glittersteentjes het woord priceless...

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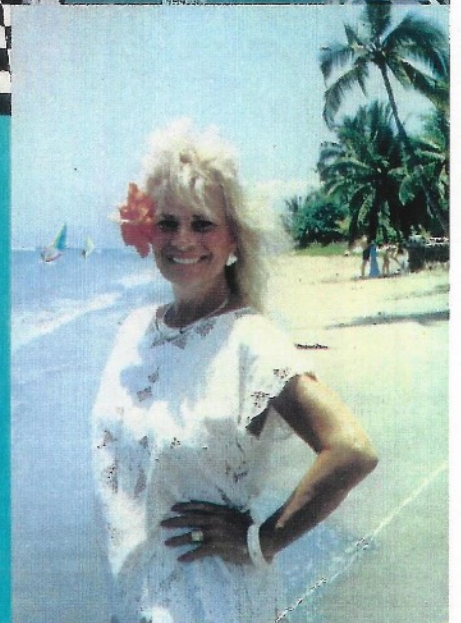

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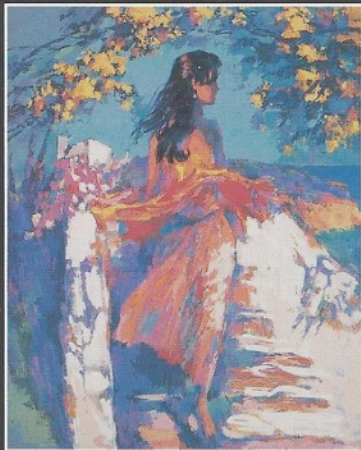
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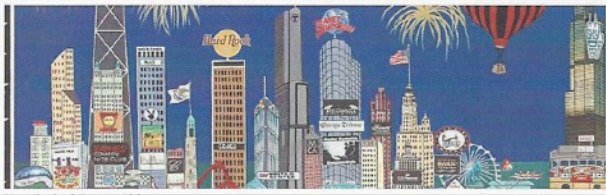
